

1. ***Amelanchier alnifolia Regent* – Regent Serviceberry (new Variety) NATIVE**



**Color: White Shades Height: 4-6 ft Spread: 4-6ft Zone: 2-9**

- Star Pollinator! Food source for wildlife (mammals, caterpillars, birds)
- Clusters of pure white flowers in spring, yellow-red fall foliage
- Blueberry-like fruit in summer
- Good for naturalizing or for use in landscape
- Deer and rabbit resistant

2. ***Aronia melanocarpa* –Low Scape Mound Aronia Black Chokeberry (New Variety) NATIVE Developed at UCONN**



**Color: White Shades Height: 12-24" Spread: 18-24" Zone: 3-9**

- Unique low-growing , mounded habit, good habit for caterpillars and wildlife
- Tidy mound of glossy green foliage
- Dainty white flowers in spring
- Brilliant fall foliage contrast with dark purple-black fruit
- Thrives in any conditions, sun-shade, cold to hot climates

3. ***Arctostaphylos uva-ursi* Bearberry NATIVE**



**Color: White to pink Height: 6-12" Spread: 4-6 ft Zone: 3-8**

- Top favorite of New England Flower Garden!
- Four full seasons of interest!
- Bell-shaped flowers favorite of bees, good winter food source for birds
- Flowers in spring, berries in summer, shades of purple-red in fall
- Dark **Evergreen** foliage, good dense ground cover

4. ***Hydrangea arborescens Invincibelle Wee White'* (New variety)**



**Color: White Shades Height: 12-30" Spread: 12-30" Zone: 4-9 Spacing: 24-36"**

- First dwarf, Annabelle hydrangea type in the world!
- Blooms from early summer through frost, looks like a bouquets of flowers
- Does not need deadheading
- Dwarf habit with strong sturdy stems; tidy, mounded habit
- Full to part sun

5. ***Buddleia x 'Pugster Blue'* (Butterfly Bush) (New variety)**



**Color: Blue shades Height: 22-24" Spread: 24-36" Zone: 5-9 Spacing: 36-48"**

- Attracts butterflies
- Fragrant, true-blue flowers
- Re-bloomer and long blooming
- Drought tolerant, hardiest of all dwarf Buddleias
- Compact form, full sun, mulch heavily in winter

6. ***Cephalanthus occidentalis* – Sugar Shack Sugar Shack Button Bush (New Variety) NATIVE**



**Color: White Shades Height: 3-4ft Spread: 3-4 ft Zone: 4-10 Spacing: 3-4ft**

- White fragrant flowers, colorful red fruit, glossy foliage
- New dwarf size of this prized **NATIVE!**
- Nesting site and source of food for birds, nectar and food for bees and caterpillars
- Good for rain gardens or at waters edge
